Membership

Sir Knights we have a lot of work to do this year, our main focus is going to be on membership. Membership is the lifeblood of our organization and we are going to set some ambitious goals this year. I plan to have a statewide membership drive and to reward each Sir Knight who top line signs a new petition. As the Templar year progresses, a monthly total kept for each Sir Knight who promotes growing our membership, not only by new petitions, but also encouraging those SK or Former SK who are currently demitted or suspended.

There will be five levels for which a Sir Knight can receive credit which are 5 points, 10 points, 20 points, 40 points and 60 points. Points can be earned by the following: top line signing a new petition 1 point or top line signing a reinstatement application 1/2 a point.

Each of the points will be awarded upon the member being knighted or reinstated and then properly reported to the Grand Commandery. As you earn the points, please contact your District membership committee member so they will be able to update your point balance. The Sir Knight earning the most points in each district will receive a special district winner award. Good luck to all Sir Knights and remember the Commandery is the Christian part of masonry...That is our biggest selling point. Sir Knights our membership target is 2000 new and reinstated members, I know this is a very lofty goal, but in this case it is better to set a goal that is almost too high than to set one that is too low. I believe that by working together we will be able to meet and surpass this goal.

My membership committee has been instructed to work will local Chapters to help organize complete festivals or just Commandery only conferrals in each of our nine districts. I will be glad to personally travel, when requested, to each district to confer the Order of the Temple. I would also at this time like to offer my services to any Commandery that will work with my schedule, to confer the Order of the Temple at their local festival.
