Unity Lodge #1242 was chartered on December 2, 1926 as Isom Lodge #1242 (Changed name to Unity in 2007). During its 83 year history, the lodge has had 73 different Worshipful Masters. Six Masters served for two terms, while two Masters served three terms. The lodge has conferred over 4,700 EA, FC, and MM Degrees.
