

Robert O. "Bob" Schnell

8-10-1924----6-29-2002

Banker, cattleman, electrician, pilot, Sunday School teacher, community leader; just a few of the varied interests of Most Worshipful Robert O. "Bob" Schnell - 154th Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Texas, who was elevated to the highest office in Texas Masonry on December 5, 1992.

He was raised a Master Mason on October 25, 1948 in Hansford Lodge No. 1040 at Spearman and served as Worshipful Master of that lodge in 1959-1960. He served as District Deputy Grand Master of Masonic District No. 102 under appointment by Grand Master Robert B. O'Connor in 1975, and answered the call of Grand Master Robert H. "Bob" Waters to again serve as District Deputy in 1984. A strong supporter of the Grand Lodge Endowed Membership Program, Bob held endowed memberships in Hansford, Adobe Walls, Wichita Falls and Holland lodges. In addition, he was a member of the Sam Houston Hall of Fame, an endowment fund for the maintenance of the Grand Lodge Library and Museum in Waco.

A man who firmly believed that Freemasonry offers something of interest to every Mason, Bob was active in the York Rite, Scottish Rite, Shrine, Eastern Star, DeMolay and many other related orders and organizations.

The passing of Brother Schnell from this world was a loss to Masonry, his community, and family.
