

Unity Lodge #1242 was presented with the Vanguard Award for the 4th year in a row during the Grand Lodge Session held in Waco, Texas on December 2, 2010.



The award was presented to Worshipful Master Raymond R. Renfroe by Most Worshipful Orville O'Neal, Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Texas. Unity Lodge was again the only lodge in the Texas Panhandle to receive the award.



Dues Increase for 2011

The annual Grand Lodge of Texas was held December 2, 2010 through December 4, 2010 in Waco Texas. The major item discussed at Grand Lodge was an increase in per-capita dues. The percapita has not been raise in several years, and Texas has one of the lowest in the nation. This has created a problem for the Grand Lodge. In it's efforts to help the smaller lodges a number of Grand Lodge programs had been discontinued or scaled back.

Now with the decrease in membership and increase in lodge repairs the Grand Lodge is being forced to raise the per-capita on its members. The percapita has been raised from \$14.75 per member to \$25.00 per member each year.

Brethren, now we must raise dues in the lodge. I know this will create a small hardship on those with fixed incomes, however Unity Lodge #1242 has one of lowest annual dues in the state. Most lodges are charging \$75.00 to \$150.00 for annual dues.

The proposal brought forth in the lodge is \$60.00 per year. Hopefully this will allow us to continue for several years without raising dues again.

This is not a step the lodge takes lightly, but we hope it will preserve our lodge for many years in the future to serve the members and our community.
