

Grand Chapter and Council 2016

On Monday October 17, 2016 and Tuesday October 18, 2016 the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Texas and the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Texas held their annual communication in Waco Texas.

Most Excellent W. David Melear, Grand High Priest of the Grand Royal Arch Masons of Texas and a member of Amarillo Chapter #196 presided.

Most Illustrious Terry Flippo Grand Master of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Texas and a member of Borger Council #354 presided over the Grand Session



Companion Kevin W. Smith of Borger Chapter #437 was installed as District Deputy Grand High Priest of Capitular District #33 Companion Milton Skipper of Amarillo Chapter #196 and Companion Bob Clemmons of Lubbock were presented with the Golden Keystone Award by Most Excellent Grand High Priest David Melear.
